

ENTRY & APPLICATION CRITERIA

- 1. Be likely to meet the required standards for a Doctorate degree.
- 2. At least 5 years of working experience in the managerial position.
- 3. Show evidence of research skills equivalent to those expected of a traditional Doctoral student in the relevant discipline.
- 4. Submit a completed application form together with:
- 5. Statement of intent,
- 6. All previous education qualification documents;
- 7. One passport size photo (in formal attire);
- 8. Passport copy (photo page) and/or copy of national ID card,
- 9. Full C.V. including all research outputs (include evidence of a unifying theme across the publications/outputs and originality),
- 10.2-3 references from previous employers.
- 11. Receive an Acceptance letter along with the Invoice.
- 12. Make the first payment to EIU.
- 13. Start the programme.



Sample Certificate:

- 1. Submit stand-alone, and/or compilation of research-based-written-work (minimum 30,000 words and maximum 35,000 words).
- 2. Demonstrate that the scholar has thoroughly and critically investigated specific area of research and made an independent and original contribution to the existing body of knowledge as well as professional practice.

Students successfully completing all the requirements for EIU's D.B.A. and D.Man. qualify to apply for an American Dual Degree (second award) from the California Metropolitan University (CMU), CA, USA (https://cmu.ac/), along with being granted Associate Member of the International Alliance for Business Professionals, IABP, USA (http://iabp.us/).
